# POLICIES

There is a registration fee of **\$25.00 per class**. This fee is nonrefundable and nontransferable but will be applied toward dance costumes if the student dances for the entire year.

All students should attend each lesson and be properly dressed. Any student who is not dressed properly or has past due tuition may not be permitted to dance with the class.

**A parent or guardian must notify the dance school if the student is unable to attend a class. We also request that a parent or guardian remain in the building during classes for students 8 years old and younger.**



- A calendar of important dates is provided to each student and is available online.
- Yearly payments are due the first day of class.
- Bi-Yearly payments are due the first day of class and January 5, 2018.
- Monthly payments are due the first day of class and the 5th of each month through May.
- The cost of classes is divided into 9 equal payments.
- A late fee of \$5.00 will be applied on unpaid balances after the 9th of each month.
- Monthly statements are emailed only when accounts are past due or when costume balances have been applied.
- A \$30.00 fee will be charged for each returned check, and future payments must be cash, credit card, or money order.
- To withdraw from classes, a parent or guardian must call the Syracuse dance school 30 days prior to the projected final class.
- There are no refunds for any tuition or costume fees.
- Costumes are not returnable.
- Payments may be paid online, mailed to the Syracuse studio, or dropped off at either dance studio. VISA, MasterCard, and Discover accepted.
- You are charged for all classes whether attended or not.

# DRESS CODE

Female student requirements:

- **solid** black leotard or approved 2-piece dance-wear for all classes
- tights may be black, light pink, white or tan
- ballet students may wear a sheer black skirt
- proper dance shoes
- no underwear is permitted under dance attire
- hip hop students may wear dance pants and a t-shirt over their dancewear
- hair secured back and off the neck (ballet bun preferred)

Male student requirements:

- **solid** black shirts
- **solid** black dance pants or shorts
- black dance shoes

Sweatshirts, sweatpants, headscarves and other apparel may not be worn during any class.

Required dance shoes include:

- Ballet—pink ballet shoes - canvas preferred
- Jazz & Jazz-Funk—tan jazz oxfords
- Tap (pre school—3rd)—tan buckle tap shoes
- Tap (4th-adult)—tan jazz tap shoes
- Hip Hop—black sequin dance sneakers

# DANCE PRODUCTION

Annual dance production:

- June 9 and 10
- held at Warsaw High School Performing Arts Center
- mandatory technical rehearsal June 5
- mandatory dress rehearsal for each show in which student performs

Some classes dance in two performances, but most classes perform in one show. Costumes for the dance production are chosen and pictures made available in January. Costumes range in price from \$50.00 to \$80.00. The costume balance is posted to accounts and a statement mailed in December with the balance due by January 5, 2018.

Unclaimed costumes will be discarded after the final June performance.

Any student who misses five or more lessons after January 1, 2018, may not be permitted to perform in the dance production. Pointe students may not miss more than three classes.

We would like for all students to participate in the dance production for the theatrical experience of their dance education; however, it is strictly optional.
